## Burgundy Wine Map Region



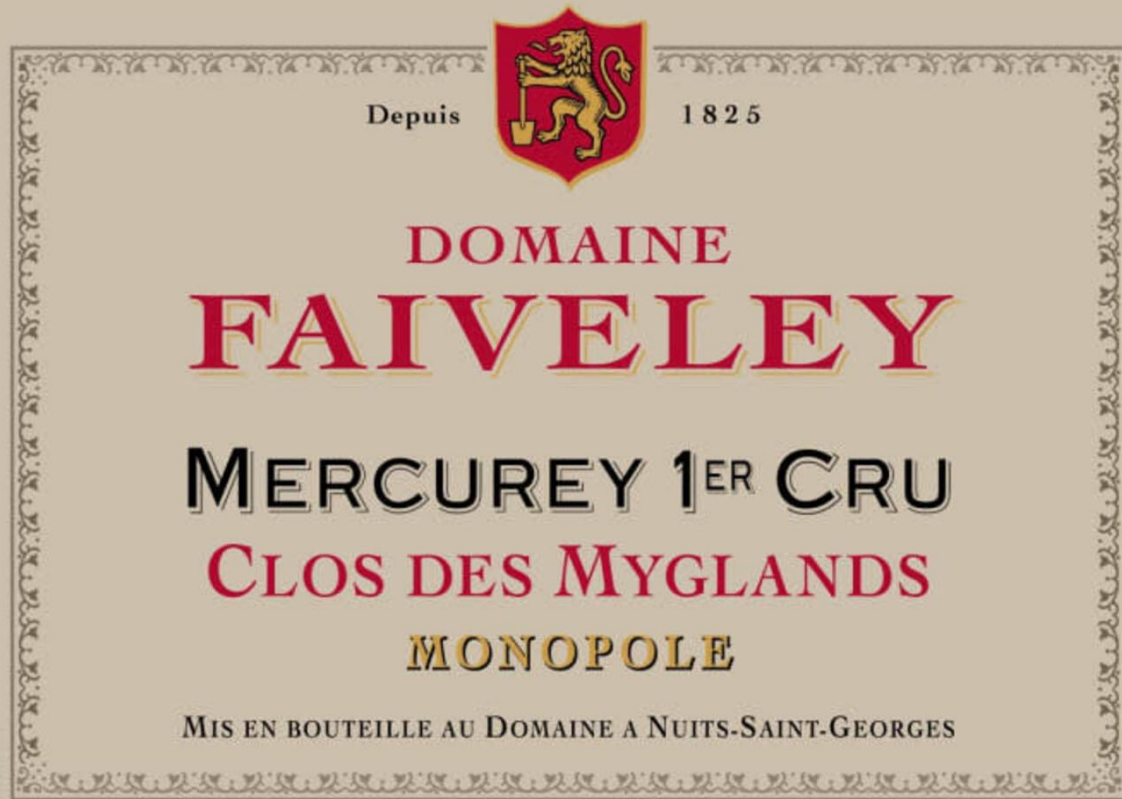

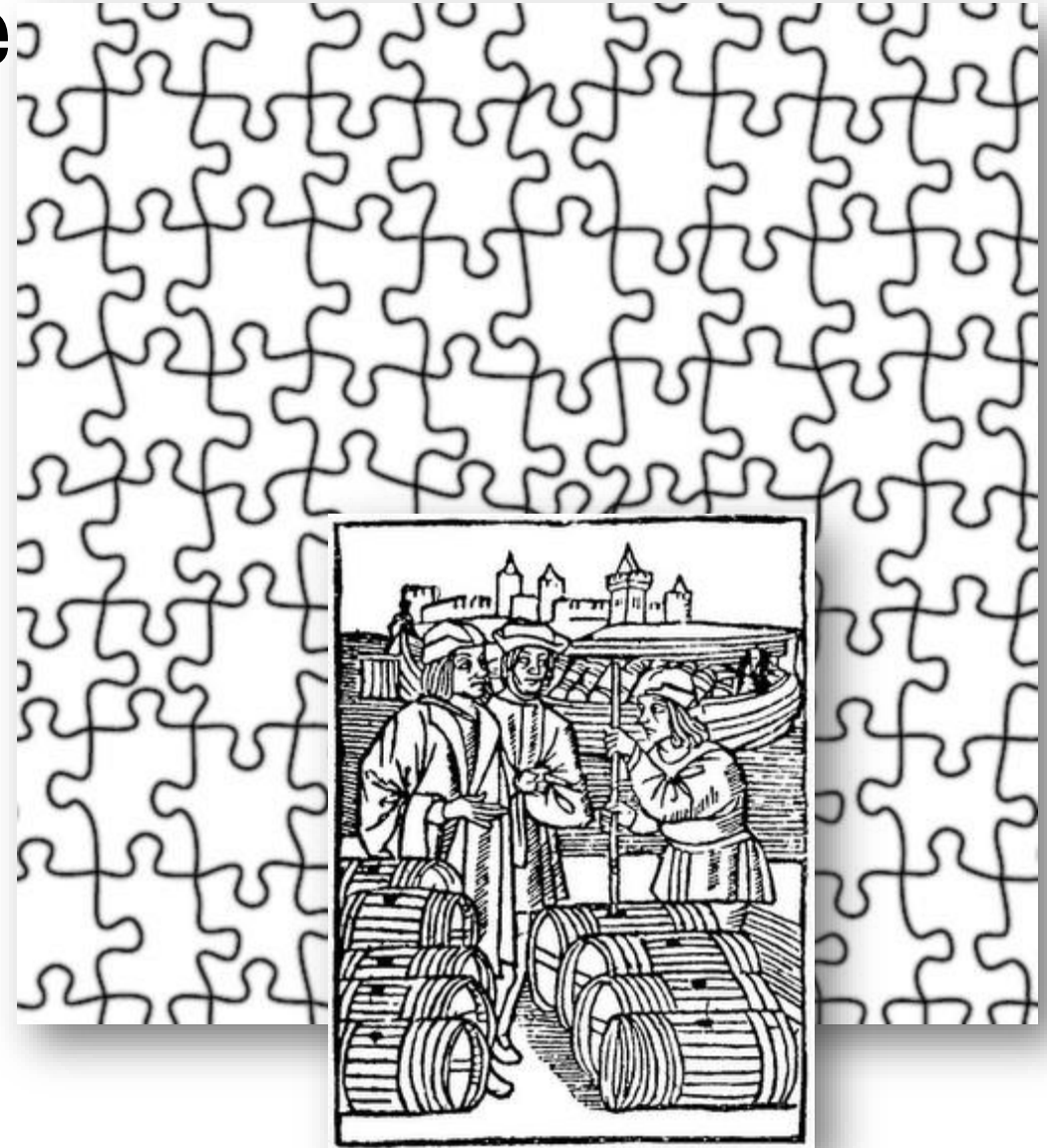
# Maconnaise

- Mediterranean influences
- **85% Chardonnay**



# Négociants and Domaine

- The average individual vineyard holding in Burgundy is **15.5 acres/6.2 ha**
- Négociants purchase grapes or wine





# Négociants and Domaines

113 négociants sell 52% of the total wine produced in Burgundy

2,828 domaines sell the balance
