
The river cruise starts on May 2, 2026 in in the beautiful Côte d'Azur city of Nice, France and travels north on the Rhone River.

Lyon Airport


Transfers to the Lyon Airport will happen and are offered at multiple times depending on when your flight departs.

Lyon Rail Station


Lyon <u>Part Dieu Rail Station</u> - it's located in the city center and buses will be available to take you there.

You will need to have the departure time available for the cruise staff to assist you in getting on the correct bus. If you need assistance in purchasing a rail ticket I can help.







